12th-21th July

The Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo

2nd-24th August

Set against the dramatic esplanade of the Edinburgh Castle, this spectacular August show is like no other. Performed by nearly 1,000 military musicians, drummers, dancers and singers with a number of special international guests and finished off with a lone bagpiper alongside a striking fireworks display, it's a Scottish night to remember.

Game On Exhibition, National Museum of Scotland

29th June–8th September

From Sonic the Hedgehog to Mario, explore gaming's rich history by playing many of the key games produced over the last 50 years. This exhibition has attracted over 5 million people of all ages, while exhibiting in 24 cities around the world. The exhibition returns to the Scottish capital for the summer, following its showing over 20 years ago in the National Museum of Scotland.

Explore Edinburgh Zoo this summer, which is home to over 1,000 rare and endangered animals and situated on 82 acres of beautiful parkland. Visit the walkthrough habitats and see monkeys, wallabies, lemurs and pelicans. Experience the incredible glass viewing tunnel, where you can see a Sumatran tiger walk right over the tunnel. For those who prefer smaller critters, head to the Wee Beasties area where you can find reptiles, amphibians and insects.

North Berwick West Beach

35 minute train journey from The Balmoral

A long stretch of beautiful sand with views to the island of Craigleith and the Bass Rock, North Berwick West Beach is a popular beach for families. It is the perfect location for sunbathing, paddling, picnics, bird watching and dog walking. For golf lovers, a putting green can be found behind the beach that is open during the summer months.

North Berwick West beach is also very close to the Lifeboat shed and within walking distance of the Scottish Seabird Centre.

Portobello Beach

30 minute bus journey and walk from The Balmoral

Portobello Beach is a charming seaside suburb, with two miles of sand making it the idyllic place for swimming and sunbathing.

The Seaside Award-winning beach welcomes large crowds in the summer and hosts a number of popular events, including the annual Big Beach Busk, triathlon events and international volleyball competitions.
